## *Narpimed project technical meeting.*

Minutes of the meeting held on September 24<sup>th</sup> 2010, Kalivia (GR).

He will review the final draft during development of a standard to provide global and specific editorial comments.

He will prepare the final text for publication and dissemination.

The project editor works with the working group and the coordinator to create a professionally produced standard.
